how to hire a CPM

Please contact Kinetec using the details provided. You will need to undertake the following:

- Complete a Hire Agreement Form and return it to Kinetec
- Kinetec will need to collect a payment for the hire period, from you, prior to CPM dispatch
- Kinetec will require a holding deposit to cover damage, loss or non-return
- The CPM will be dispatched to you once the payment has been cleared, using a next day service provided by a nationwide courier
- Kinetec do not install the CPM or fit it to the patient. This is the responsibility of the patient who can set it up themselves using the instructions provided, or can ask a local physiotherapist to set it up for them at their own expense
- At the end of the hire period you must make contact with Kinetec to arrange collection of the device or to extend the hire period. Failure to do so may result in additional charges
- The patient is responsible for the care of the device during the hire period and will be liable for any repair costs should the device be returned damaged.

what is continuous passive motion (CPM)?

Continuous Passive Motion (CPM) is a postoperative therapeutic treatment that passively – without patient effort – moves a joint through a prescribed range of motion (ROM) for a prescribed period of time. CPM devices are available for all of the major joints – knee, elbow, shoulder, hand, wrist and hip.

typical uses of CPM

Orthopaedic surgeons typically prescribe CPM following:


- Total knee replacement
- Ligament reconstruction
- Tendon repair
- Stabilised intra-articular fractures
- Meniscal repair
- Arthroscopic debridement of adhesions

CPM provides significantly better range of motion when used as part of the rehabilitation process

why use CPM?

CPM provides physiological benefits that result in faster recovery and faster return to function. If used post-operatively, CPM can:

- Help prevent joint stiffness and increase ROM
- Promote the healing of the joint surfaces and soft tissue
- Reduces swelling and pain, resulting in improved compliance with physiotherapy and exercise
- Prevent the formation of movement-limiting adhesions



clinical evidence

There are a broad range of studies and surgeon experiences that support the clinical use of CPM as part of orthopaedic rehabilitation procedures. CPM is best applied immediately post-operatively and continued for up to 6 weeks or as prescribed by the surgeon or physiotherapist.

hiring a CPM device

Kinetec provides a full range of CPMs to hire from a period as short as two weeks.

Knee CPM devices typically cost from £10 per day (minimum of 4 weeks) to £12 per day (minimum of 2 weeks) to hire. The cost includes free of charge next day delivery and collection to all mainland UK locations.

All of the CPM units are supplied with manufacturers user instructions and a set of comfortable, disposable, padded leg supports.
